- A. Please provide the number of new residential multifamily buildings that participated in IPL's energy efficiency new construction programs each year from 2004 through 2007, separated between residential and non-residential new construction.
- B. Please provide the number of new residential multifamily buildings that are estimated to participate in IPL's energy efficiency new construction programs for each of the Plan years from 2009 through 2013, separated between residential and non-residential new construction.

Response

- A. Multifamily facilities were not eligible for participation in the residential new construction program from 2004 through 2008. Customers received rebates for eligible equipment through the prescriptive rebates program.

Multifamily facilities were eligible for participation in the Commercial New Construction program since the programs inception. One facility has been completed, a Cedar Rapids nursing home.
- B. IPL does not have an estimated number of residential multifamily buildings, as the residential and non-residential new construction programs did differentiate between building types when establishing participation goals.
