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Please provide for each month of the last five year EEP Plan a copy of each written contract or agreement involving any aspect of coordination of any portion of Interstate Power and Light Company's energy measure, program or plan with:

- A. Any other utility sharing in whole or in part Interstate's service territory;
- B. Any other utility not sharing Interstate's service territory.

Response

Interstate Power and Light Company's (IPL's) hard copies of the requested contracts or agreements are stored in IPL's general office (G.O.) in downtown Cedar Rapids. IPL evacuated that building on June 11th due to Cedar River flooding conditions with the expectation at that time that the evacuation would be of a short duration. The flooding was worse than anticipated. IPL staff members with knowledge of those contracts continue to be evacuated from the G.O., working from their homes, and do not expect to be able to return their offices for several weeks.
