**Data Request No. 32**

Pursuant to earlier informal dialogue (IPL response to informal DR 8), it was OCA's understanding that there is no cost difference between steel doors and standard wooden doors. Please explain the basis for the \$50 rebate in Table 1 of Appendix B, which purports to be 24% of incremental cost?

**Response**

This measure is viewed as a retrofit, replacing a functioning standard wooden door. Therefore the cost is full, not incremental. The cost of a steel door is estimated to be \$210 in the Joint Utility Assessment.
